NOVICE

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **COVID-19 regulations MUST be adhered to at all times, including 1.5 m Social Distancing. If displaying any flu like symptoms of COVID-19....please do not attend**
2. Judging will be in accordance with rules as set out, and in accordance with the standards of the Orchid Society of NSW Inc. and AOC.
3. The Judge's decisions will be final at all times. No correspondence or discussion to take place outside of this group.
4. Entry is free and open to all financial Members of any affiliated society of OSNSW or AOC
5. All Orchids must be clean and disease free. The Show Marshall and/or a representative may request plants be removed from the venue
6. Benching is strictly between 10am and 12midday, Friday 11th September 2020. Judging to begin @ 1pm.
7. Orchids to be correctly and clearly labelled
8. Once registered, plant number must be attached to the pot so it can be easily seen by the Judges, then placed into their correct (Class) position on the bench.
9. Exhibitor must have owned and grown all orchids for six months prior to the Show.
10. **Miniature** has the following meaning: "an orchid having a flower size not exceeding 15mm and the and a distance of < 200mm from 1st to last flower
11. **First flowering seedling** shall mean the complete plant (hybrids and species) raised from seed and flowering for the first time. Mericlones are ineligible. Divisions of plants are ineligible.
12. The Show Marshall has the right to remove, reject or rearrange any plant, or move into a new class. Any new classes created will have at least 4 plants and 4 left in the old section.
13. **Staking** shall be in accordance with the rules of the OSNSW.
 - a) Flowers may be supported in the best possible manner for presentation. Any support should be in a manner so as not to be obtrusive and distract from the overall beauty and charm of the plant
 - b) Flowers shall not be tied or supported above the lowest flower
 - c) Inflorescences shall not be tied or supported above the lowest flower
 - d) In the case of branching racemes, they shall not be tied or supported above the uppermost branch
 - e) Where plants are tied above the bottom flower or top branch, the Judges are permitted to penalise, or temporarily remove such tie/s for the purpose of judging
 - f) Ties must be removable. Cable ties and sticky tapes are not acceptable
 - g) Points will be deducted for obtrusive and dangerous staking where the stake protrudes above the flowers and large ornamental clips that detract from the floral display
14. No award will be given if, in the opinion of the judges, it is not warranted. The Society may give other prizes.
15. During Judging, recorders to remain well behind Judges. All others not involved in the process, must move well away from the judging area and not interfere in any way. This rule is a directive from the OSNSW Judging Group
16. No Exhibit shall be removed before the termination of the show without the permission of the Show Marshall. Show terminates at 3.00pm Sunday 13th September 2020
17. The Show Marshall reserves the right to vary the rules wherever may be warranted
18. Entries are accepted on the basis that the organizers shall take all reasonable care of the exhibits, and miscellaneous items, in the Display area, but shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or destruction to such items, and exhibitors shall have no claim against any society or group.
19. Wyong Spring Time Orchid Show Committee or displaying Societies reserve the right to photograph, for their own purposes, any exhibit in the display. Photos taken by any group have copyrights and may be used for future advertising
